He won the 2015 National Book Award for Young People's Literature for *Challenger Deep* and his novel, *Scythe*, was a 2017 Michael L. Printz Honor book, and is in development with Universal Studios as a

feature film. His novel, *Unwind*, has become part of the literary canon in many school districts across the country-and has won more than thirty domestic and international awards. Shusterman is currently co-writing the pilot episode of Netflix's adaptation of his *Game Changer*, while his harrowing tale of survival, *Dry*, is in development at Paramount Pictures.
